Fees over \$50.00 must be paid by check, made payable to the Stanly County Board of Elections.

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ORGANIZING A COMMITTEE:

Within 10 days of filing for office, receiving or spending the first dollar on the campaign, or upon the candidate's public statement of intent to file for office (whichever occurs first) each candidate must establish a Candidate Committee. **If you are seeking elective office in the State of NC, you have a committee, even if you (the candidate) are the only person on the committee. ALL candidates must complete the following items within 10 days.**

- 1. The committee must be given a name;** this can be just the candidate's name John Doe, or Committee to Election John Doe, or John Doe for (office), etc. The committee name will be used to identify campaign materials requiring a legend (media ads, flyers, etc.).
- 2. Each committee must also have a treasurer.** The candidate may be the treasurer or may appoint anyone except his/her spouse. The treasurer is responsible for keeping up with all the transactions of the committee, and for filing the appropriate reports. Every treasurer must complete mandatory training from the SBE within three months and once every four years. If not completed, treasurers may not sign reports. Reports submitted by a treasurer w/o training are subject to penalties.
- 3. The candidate must disclose a financial account number and determine if over \$1000 will be spent or received by the committee. NEW LAW:** Committees must use a separate bank account for their campaign. Candidates and treasurers can no longer use personal account(s) for the committee.

If a candidate will not raise or spend ANY money other than the filing fee, a bank account is not required. This certification must be made at the time of filing.

Forms will be issued to all committees at the time of filing. Additional information is available at our website www.votestanlycounty.com and the State Board of Elections www.sboe.state.nc.us .

FILING FOR OFFICE 2012

If over \$1000 is to be spent the committee will be required to file reports outlining contributions, expenditures, loans, etc. The first report due is the Organizational Report; this covers the first 10 days of the committee's transactions.

Reports may be submitted in person, via mail, courier, or electronically. Software is free. Electronic filing is required for committees spending more than \$5000 toward a state-wide office.

**ALL reports must include the following forms:
CRO-1000 Disclosure Report Cover & CRO-1100 Detailed Summary Sheet**

In addition, every amount recorded on the Detailed Summary Sheet should be backed up with the corresponding form listed to the left of the line. Example \$1000.00 in contributions over \$50 would be reported on CRO-1210, and \$250.00 in expenditures would be reported on CRO-1310.

CONTRIBUTIONS

DO NOT ACCEPT OVER \$50.00 IN CASH! Contributions over \$50.00 (**including loans from the candidate**) must be made by check and the following information obtained: The contributor's name, address, occupation, date contribution is made, and a sum to date total of all contributions.

A record of contributions under \$50.00 must be kept, but the only information that must be reported is the amount of the contribution and the date it is made.

If a person contributes \$25.00 today then \$30.00 next month, the contributor's information must be reported once they give over \$50.00.

Non-monetary contributions, such as office supplies, labor, food, etc. are considered In-Kind contributions. These must be given monetary value and reported on the appropriate form. These are reported as a contribution and expenditure to even things out.

No more than \$4,000 may be accepted from an individual per election cycle. The following persons may contribute and unlimited amount of funds: the candidate, candidate's spouse, parents, brothers, and sisters.

EXPENDITURES

DO NOT SPEND OVER \$50.00 IN CASH! Expenditures over \$50.00 must be paid by check, except postage.

ALL expenditures for media purposes must be paid by check.

All expenditures must be recorded and receipts should be kept for all expenditures.

The following information must be provided for those over \$50.00: Name and address of payee, date of expenditure, & purpose of expenditure.

All expenditures must be relevant to committee expenses or that of holding office. It is unlawful to use committee funds for personal use.

Expenditures that are not media related and are under \$50 may be paid by cash and reported as an aggregate amount. This means the payee does not have to be disclosed; however, the date and specific amount the expenditures are required.
