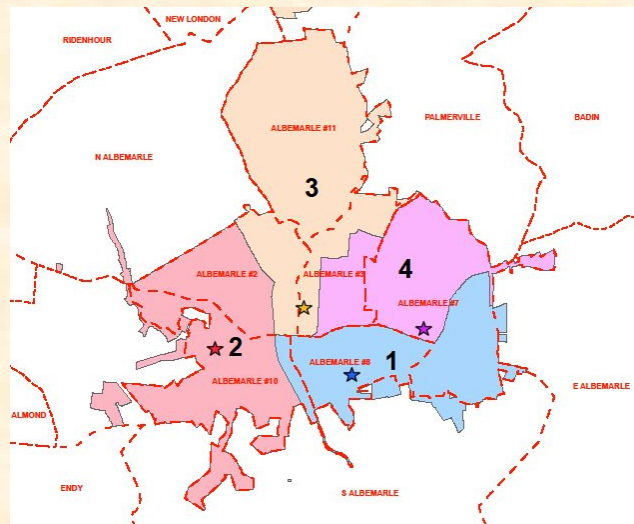

August 21st – **Voter Registration Deadline - Books Close Applications must be post-marked, faxed**, emailed as scanned document, or hand delivered by this date.**

ASAP – **Begin mailing Absentee By-Mail Ballots**

ASAP – **One-Stop Absentee Voting Begins at Stanly County Board of Elections Office**

September 29th – **Last Day to apply for Absentee By-Mail Ballots AND last day to mail out Absentee By-Mail Ballots**

**In-person sick & disabled requests accepted through Oct. 5th, Contact us for details*

October 3rd – **Last Day for One-Stop Absentee Voting**

October 5th – **5:00 p.m. Deadline to return ALL Ballots**

October 6th – **Second Primary, Polls open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.**

OTHER INFORMATION

Absentee By Mail Voting

Any registered voter who cannot go to the polls to vote on Election Day can request an absentee ballot to be mailed to them. The request for this ballot must be in writing and must include the voter's printed name & address as they are registered, the address to mail the ballot to, DOB of voter, and signature.
