October 4th—Begin mailing Absentee By-Mail Ballots

October 9th – Voter Registration Deadline - Books Close Applications must be post-marked, faxed, emailed as scanned document, or hand delivered by this date.**

October 14th – **Deadline to receive originals of faxed registrations for new voters or party changes

October 15th – One-Stop Absentee Voting Begins at Stanly County Board of Elections Office

October 27th – Last Day to apply for Absentee By-Mail Ballots AND last day to mail out Absentee By-Mail Ballots

October 31st – Last Day for One-Stop Absentee Voting

November 2nd – 5:00 p.m. Deadline to return ALL Ballots

Absentee By Mail Voting

Any registered voter who cannot go to the polls to vote on Election Day can request an absentee ballot to be mailed to them. The request for this ballot must be in writing and must include the voter's printed name & address as they are registered, the address to mail the ballot to, DOB of voter, and signature.
