DATES TO REMEMBER for 2009

August 16th – **Begin mailing Absentee By-Mail Ballots**

August 21st – **Voter Registration Deadline - Books Close Applications must be postmarked, faxed**, emailed as scanned document, or hand delivered by this date.**

August 26th – ****Deadline to receive originals of faxed registrations for new voters or party changes**

August 27th – **One-Stop Absentee Voting Begins at Stanly County Board of Elections Office**

September 8th – **Last Day to apply for Absentee By-Mail Ballots AND last day to mail out Absentee By-Mail Ballots**

***In-person sick & disabled requests accepted through Sept. 14th, Contact us for details**

September 12th – **Last Day for One-Stop Absentee Voting**

September 14th – **5:00 p.m. Deadline to return ALL Ballots**

September 15th – **General Election, Polls open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.**

OTHER INFORMATION

Absentee By Mail Voting

Any registered voter who cannot go to the polls to vote on Election Day can request an absentee ballot to be mailed to them. The request for this ballot must be in writing and must include the voter's printed name & address as they are registered, the address to mail the ballot to, DOB of voter, and signature.

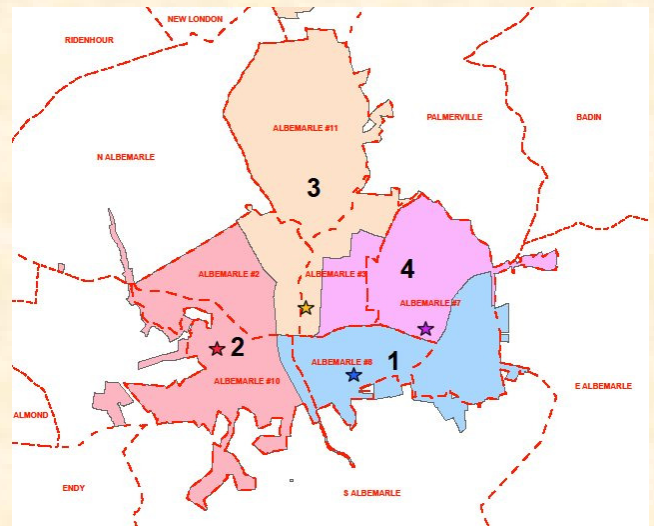
