

## Notice of Polling Places and Buffer Zones

The following is a list of polling places for the November 8, 2011 election and a description of each buffer zone concerning Election Day electioneering. Buffer zones as designated by G.S. 163-166.4(a), county board of elections, shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet.

The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with “No Campaigning Beyond This Point” signs. Electioneering will be allowed as noted:

50 ft from the outside entrance to the gym
